One special memory was of a man with Down Syndrome at Newel Post Senior Citizen Day Care, who we visited two times a month. He was very afraid of dogs and would never come over to the big room where we visited all of the people. I noticed him one time in the other room and asked a staff member if he would like to see Rose. The staff member told me how afraid he was of dogs and that he will never come to pet Rose. Well, this went on for months, and then one visit I noticed him peeking down the hallway at us. After a lot more visits, I noticed him taking a step closer each time down the hallway closer to the large room everyone was in. One day he was about six feet from the doorway and Rose noticed him, walked over, laid her head against the outside of his knee and sat down. He reached down and started petting her head. Everyone could not believe what they were seeing. A lot of the staff members were crying and taking pictures. Even the residents there were so surprised. Rose just sat perfectly still and let him keep petting her for a long time. After that day, every time Rose and I came, he was waiting by the door for us so he could be the first person to pet her. Everyone loved her so much and was excited each time we would come to visit again. I think of how many people she touched with the care and love she had for everyone and how much she loved her job of making people happy by just petting her.
